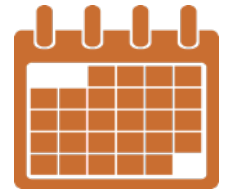

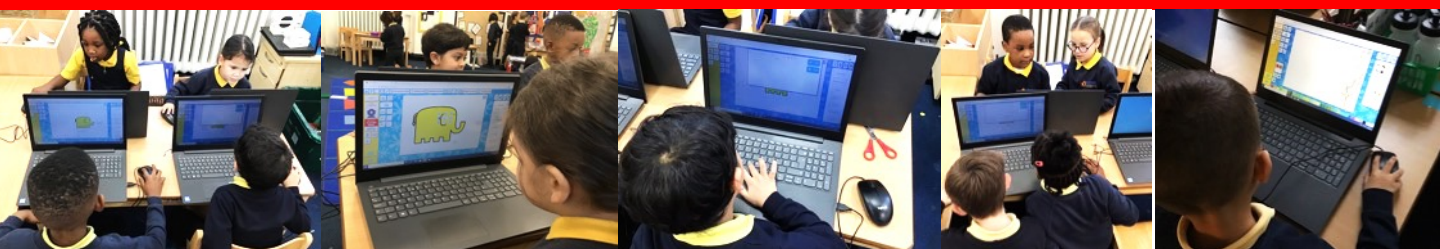
What's been happening at Morningside?



We have been very busy this half term in Nursery. We have been practicing our balancing skills outside Creating our Christmas decorations.

Play dough - creating play dough winter snowmen and Christmas scenes.

Coloured water - creating potions and practicing our pouring and filling skills.

The children who stay all day enjoyed their lunch.

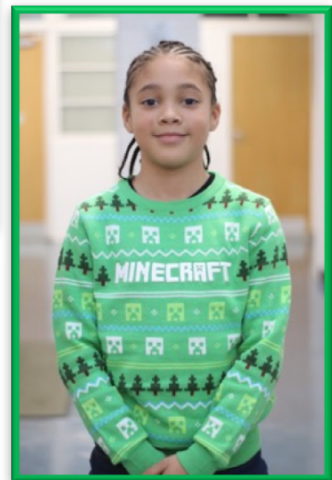
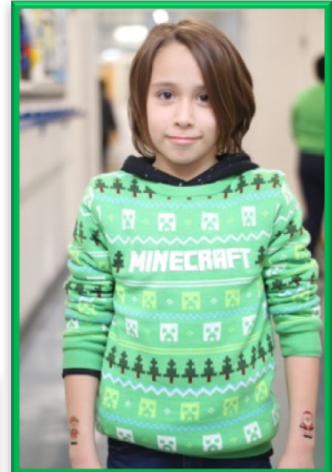

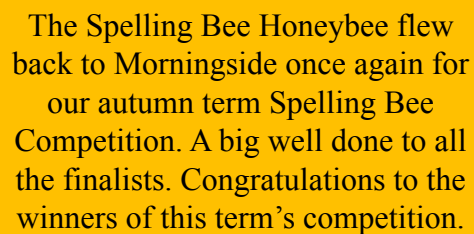
We have also really enjoyed Storytime and acting the story for each other.

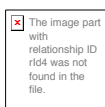

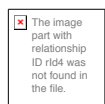
