What a fantastic time the am nursery class have had a forest school! We learned how to climb trees, build birds nests and make food for the animals.

Reception have had a busy week searching for minibeasts, building a wormery and observing the seeds we planted.


In our RE lessons, Year 1 are learning about Hanukkah, we made hanukkiahs.

Year 2 have been creating clay tiles. We experimented with the clay by using different techniques. We used tools to create impressions and relief images. Our work is inspired by Ladi Kwali and Kate Malone.
