Learning at MORNINGSIDE





Nursery: The children had a lovely time in their new class this week. They were very busy making, drawing, painting and trying out different healthy foods during snack time.

The children in reception have settled well and have had a fantastic start over the past two weeks.









Year 1: 1M and 1S have been having a great time settling into their new yeargroup. It has been so nice seeing our friends again and exploring our new classrooms.

Year 2: In DT, we were tasting different vegetables and used our 5 senses to describe how they look, feel, taste, smell and what sounds they make when we eat them







Learning at MORNINGSIDE

In Year 3, we did a science experiment to explore how quickly germs can spread. We used glitter to represent the "germs", then touched it and dropped food into it. We noticed it spreads very quickly - we now know we need to wash our hands before eating!









Year 4: Here is a picture of 4M winning the school behaviour award of lollies and extra play. There is also a picture of children mixing colours together to make different shades of green for leaves, which will be the background for our portraits.

In Year 5 we investigated different ways to make four tenths using multi link cubes in Maths, discussing how tenths arise when a whole is divided into ten equal parts.









Wow! Year 6 really impressed with their geography knowledge this afternoon. We learned about 6-figure grid references and used our new skills to go on a mapbased Ordnance Survey treasure hunt!
