We all have a voice and our opinions should be heard. If we want to help care for and protect natural habitats, we can use our voice and take action.

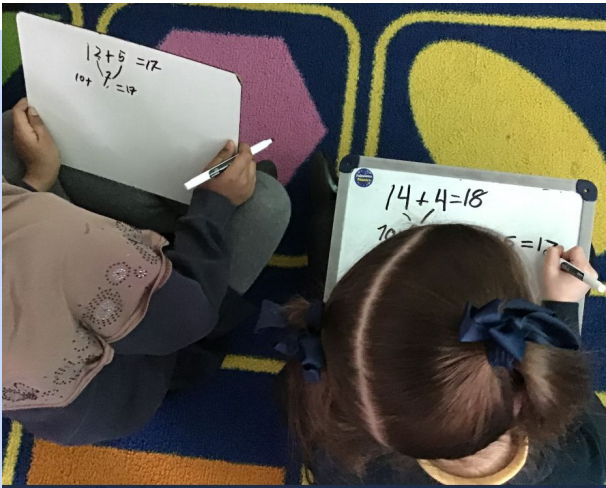
What's happening in the news this week?

Year 4 PSHE this week. They learned how to work as a team and talked about how we can stay happy and healthy



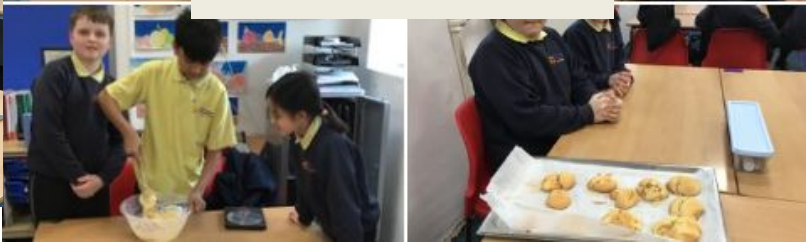
Year 3 have been learning all about databases and how to filter information in their computing lessons
