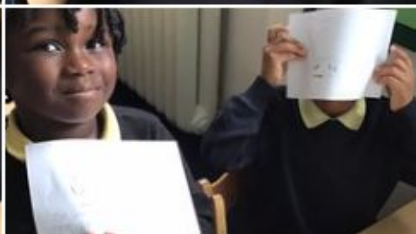
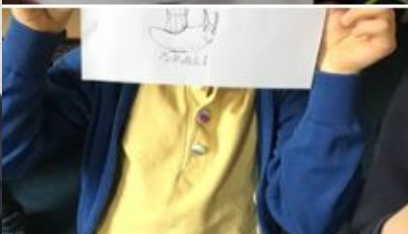
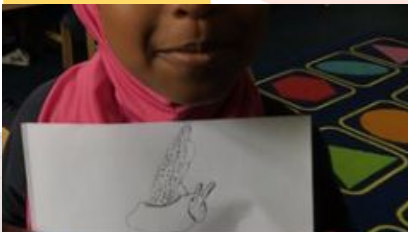

My behaviour, actions and words can affect others. Volunteering is an action that can affect others in a positive way and help make a difference to their lives.



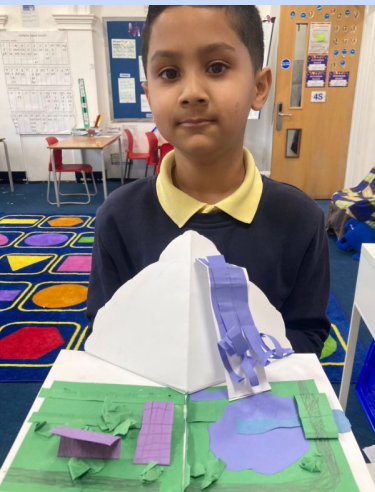
Amazing illustrators in Year 3 thought of words to describe the character for their writing this week.



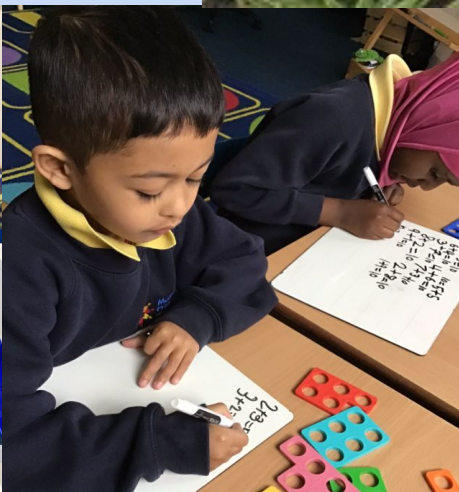
Fabulous Year 5 teamwork this week. They took part in a STEAM workshop and were challenged to build a raft
