 <p>physical</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• I look at who is talking, using eye contact to show active listening• My hands are on my lap or flat on the table• I use body language to show active listening (nodding, facial expressions)• I project my voice and vary my tone and volume for effect
 <p>linguistic</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• I speak in sentences using conjunctions to sequence ideas• I take opportunities to use sophisticated sentence stems and create my own• I use sophisticated vocabulary
 <p>cognitive</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• I give reasons to support my views• I build on, challenge, clarify or probe others' ideas• I am prepared to change my mind
 <p>social and emotional</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• I listen to the opinions of others• I respect others' ideas• I invite others' into the discussion• I use other children's names when referring to their point
