How does your garden grow?

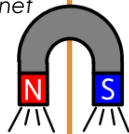
- Explore the requirements of a flowering plant

Kosher, Kashrut rules from the Torah, foods that are treif and parev; the story of the Passover and the symbolism of the Seder plate.

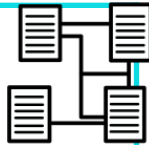
